## Village Arts Factory's Fine Art Gallery to Exhibit Works By Rick Goff

**(Canton, MI – May 7, 2024)** The Fine Art Gallery at the Village Arts Factory is proud to present the featured artwork of artist Rick Goff in a special exhibit, entitled “Images of Spring (Mostly)”, which is on public display now through May 28, 2024. A gallery open house and artist’s opening reception will be held on Wednesday, May 8, from 6 – 8 p.m., allowing viewers to browse Goff’s artwork, meet the artist, and enjoy a variety of light refreshments. This event is free to attend and is open to the public.

A painter for more than 40 years, Rick Goff’s exhibit features a range of his work, subject matter, and representational style. His paintings are rendered in gouache applied over a background of India ink on watercolor paper, resulting in vibrant colors and bright hues.

In addition to being a University of Michigan alum, Goff is also a board member of the Michigan Watercolor Society, a signature artist of the Virginia Watercolor Society, and a juried member of Potomac Valley Watercolorists. Following a long career in municipal government, Goff now retired, lives in Ann Arbor, and participates in the Sunday Artisan Market at Kerrytown Market and Shops.
